





BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

POTENTIAL INDUSTRIAL PARK DEVELOPMENT SITE #1 (HWY 53)


- Estimated total investment costs of \$3.5MM
- DADC Board approved sequential park strategy
- Expansion potential of current industrial development through collaboration with Board of Commissioners (MOU)



BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

POTENTIAL INDUSTRIAL PARK DEVELOPMENT SITE #2 (HWY 400N)

- Two (2) Georgia Tech's CEDR economic impact studies of proposed mixed-use development
 - a. <u>Fiscal impact modeling</u> customized to Dawson county parameters
 - b. <u>Economic Impact Modeling</u> estimated new jobs that the project creates for indirect and induced impact



WEST HIGHTOWER RESURFACING

- On hold until adoption of Special Tax District policy is completed by Dawson County.
- Majority of affected property owners remain committed





PEAKS OF DAWSON PROJECT UPDATE

- BoC approved new TEFRA application at 9/2/2021 meeting.
- Required public hearing and supplemental Bond Resolution Adopted September 15, 2021 by Dawson County Development
- Revenue bonds closed and sold September 22nd
- Construction complete in 14-18 months after funding closes.
