Public Notice:

O.C.G.A. §21-2-386(2)(A) and SEB Rule 183-1-14-.14 allows county election superintendents to begin opening absentee oath envelopes that have been verified and accepted, and scanning absentee ballots on ICCs. Early processing and scanning shall be open to the public. Therefore:

Dawson County Board of Elections & Registration will begin the opening and scanning of absentee ballots beginning December 1, 2022.

Time: 10 am to 6 pm daily, as needed, until completion prior to the December 6<sup>th</sup> General Election Runoff.

Location: Board of Elections Office at 96 Academy Avenue, Dawsonville, GA 30534

The process will not produce any tabulated results or any partially tabulated results, but only allow for the opening and scanning of voted absentee ballots. These opened and scanned ballots will be tabulated after the close of election on December 6, 2022.
